

ENTRANCE AGE REQUIREMENTS

A student may enter kindergarten if the child's chronological age will be five (5) before September 30 of the year entering school. *No waiver of this kindergarten entrance age provision shall be granted. Policy JEB-R shall not apply.*

A student may enter Grade 1 if the child's chronological age will be six (6) before September 30 of the year entering school.

A birth certificate must be presented upon registration as proof of the date of birth.

Incoming transfer students in Grades 2-6 inclusive will be initially placed in accordance with the date forwarded by the sending district. Such placement is tentative and subject to reassignment by the Superintendent of Schools or their designee.

Incoming transfer students in Grade 1 will only be initially admitted to Grade 1 if their chronological age will be six (6) before September 30 of the year of entering school or if previously enrolled in Grade 1 in another community. Such placement is tentative and subject to reassignment by the Principal after developmental/academic evaluation.
