NEW BOSTON SCHOOL DISTRICT

ADMISSION OF NON-RESIDENT STUDENTS (AND TUITION)

Nonresident students who show sufficient evidence that they will be establishing residency in the District may, at the discretion of the Board, be granted a grace period from tuition charges not to exceed 45 calendar days from the first day of the school year. Tuition charges will begin on the 46th calendar day and continue until the student becomes a legal resident of the District. Tuition will be charged at a rate set by the Board and billed quarterly in advance to the sending District or parent responsible for payment. When a sending District is responsible for tuition, approval must be received from the sending District School Board.

Seniors who reside in New Boston and move out of New Boston in their senior year may continue to the end of the current school year, with tuition paid by the New Boston School District, with the approval of the Superintendent and the School Board.
