

**EVALUATION OF INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAMS**

The purpose of evaluation of instructional programs will be:

1. To determine educational needs and provide information for planning and review of curriculum.
2. To indicate instructional strengths and weaknesses of the curriculum and instructional practices.
3. To check on the suitability of programs in terms of school curriculum, state standards assessments, instruction and community requirements.
4. To show the relationship between achievement and the system's stated goals.
5. To provide data for public information.

Instructional programs shall be directed by the Superintendent in cooperation with the School District Curriculum Committee and the School Principal.

It shall be the responsibility of the Superintendent to report periodically to the School Board on the progress the District is making toward the achievement of its instructional programs.
