



Walker Rules

A “walker” is a student who walks, or rides a bike, home after school, or who is picked up after school by a parent or another authorized adult. Walkers are dismissed at 2:10 to the front entrance of the school. Please be prompt in picking up your child. To ensure the safety of your child, two teachers are on duty each day starting at 2:10. In order to keep your child safe, please observe the following:

- The lane of cars next to the curb may stand and wait until the students are released to them. A driver **MUST** be with the car at all times. This lane ends at the crosswalk by the front entrance: the area in front of that is reserved for the preschool bus.
- The second lane is for cars that have already picked up their child(ren), and are exiting the school grounds. This lane must keep moving.
- If you are going to walk up to the front entrance, you must park your car in the parking lot. Parents must wait for their children at the front entrance, and not at their classrooms.
- You may park in the parking lot to wait for your child. When your child sees you there, he/she should tell the teacher, and the teacher will cross him/her over to the parking lot area.
- There are two crosswalks. Students may **NOT** cross the far crosswalk (near the flagpole) unless accompanied by an adult.
- Students will be released to cars which are standing by the curb between the front entrance and the flagpole only.
- If your child is walking or riding a bike home, we ask that he/she check in with the teachers on duty first.
- Once students are outside, they should not reenter the building. If they need to reenter the school, they must check in with the teacher on duty first.
- Students must wait at the front entrance- not down the walkway past the school building.
- This is **NOT** a recess time, and all students (whether with parents or not) are expected to behave appropriately and safely- no running. Please remind your child(ren) of this.
- Once you have all of your children, it is asked that you move out of the entryway area so that the teachers can monitor those children who have not yet been picked up.
- The teachers on duty will have a walkie-talkie, which they can use to contact buses or the office. We can have the bus drop a student off out front, or have the office page for a student. Please see one of these teachers rather than going inside to ask at the office.

Remember, our primary duty during this period of time is to keep all of the children safe, please help us to do our job. Thank you.
