Since many of you may be visiting the pediatrician for physical updates for camp, **please be aware that an additional vaccine is required for all students prior to 7th grade entry, the TDAP (this is different from the DTAPs your child received when younger).**

The gym doors will be open from 6:40-8:30 am every Friday.** Be sure to pick up any last minute things before Friday. **Buses return to the school at 5:30 pm. 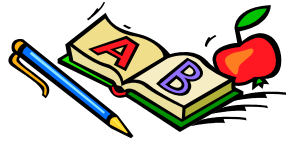
### Preschool Screening Day:

### Kindergarten/1<sup>st</sup> Grade Registration:

It is **time to register** children entering either Kindergarten or 1<sup>st</sup> Grade in the **2018-19 school year!** If your child **currently attends NBCS for Kindergarten, you do not need to do anything.**

**If you have a preschooler at NBCS, you only need to complete the Kindergarten Session Preference Form indicating what session you would like (am or pm).
