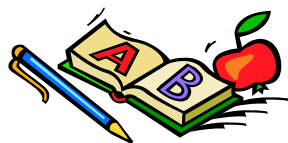
Preschool Screening Day:

If you have a preschooler at NBCS, you only need to complete the Kindergarten Session Preference Form indicating what session you would like (am or pm). **All new registrants can either stop by the office or go to our website, www.nbcs.k12.nh.us, and print off the registration documents.** We start the process this early in order to get a head count for budgeting and staffing purposes.
