1. Children's food bags are ready for pick-up at the Food Pantry:

Hours: Tuesdays, 4:00-6:00 p.m.

Fridays, 8:30-10:30 a.m.

Location: 7 North Mast Road, Goffstown

- 2. If you are ill or suffering from any symptoms of cold or flu, **do not come to the pantry**. Please call (497-3433) and leave a message with your name and contact number. We are an all-volunteer organization, so please be patient. We will return your call and make alternate arrangements to ensure you get the help you need.
- 3. If your family needs food in addition to the child-centered food bag items, we will do our best to help. You will need to visit the Food Pantry during the regular hours of Wednesday evenings, 6:00-7:30 p.m. and Saturday mornings, 10:00-11:30 a.m. Once again, if you cannot make it in, call the pantry at (497-3433) and leave a message.
- 4. For your safety, and to protect those around you, we highly recommend you follow all CDC guidelines regarding personal care: wash your hands thoroughly and often; use hand sanitizer; keep your hands away from your face; sneeze into your sleeve; keep distance between you and any sick person, clean often-used surfaces daily.
