SCHOOL NURSE

WE HAVE SEEN AN UPTICK IN ILLNESSES AMONGST OUR STUDENTS AND STAFF. IF YOUR CHILD IS NOT FEELING WELL PLEASE KEEP THEM HOME UNTIL THEY ARE FEELING BETTER. CHILDREN SHOULD BE ABLE TO PARTICIPATE IN DAILY ACTIVITIES. SOME STUDENTS MAY REQUIRE ADDITIONAL REST AT HOME. IF YOUR CHILD'S SYMPTOMS ARE NOT IMPROVING PLEASE CONTACT THEIR PROVIDER FOR FURTHER EVALUATION. COVID TESTING IS NOT REQUIRED, BUT STILL RECOMMENDED. PLEASE REMEMBER THAT CHILDREN ARE NOT ALLOWED BACK TO SCHOOL UNTIL THEY ARE 24 HOURS FEVER /VOMIT/DIARRHEA FREE (WITHOUT MEDICATION). FOR EXAMPLE, IF YOUR CHILD VOMITS AT 1PM ON A TUESDAY, THEY SHOULD NOT BE BACK IN SCHOOL UNTIL THURSDAY. THIS ALLOWS TIME FOR YOUR CHILD TO RECOVER AND REDUCES THE SPREAD OF CONTAGIOUS ILLNESSES WITHIN THE SCHOOL TO OTHER STUDENTS AND STAFF. 


