NH IMMUNIZATION INFORMATION SYSTEM

NEW HAMPSHIRE IMMUNIZATION INFORMATION SYSTEM (NHIIS) IS A SECURE, STATEWIDE, WEB-BASED SYSTEM THAT CONNECTS AND SHARES IMMUNIZATION INFORMATION AMONG PUBLIC CLINICS, PRIVATE PROVIDER OFFICES, LOCAL HEALTH DEPARTMENTS, SCHOOLS, HOSPITALS, AND OTHER HEALTH CARE FACILITIES THAT ADMINISTER IMMUNIZATIONS AND PROVIDE MEDICAL CARE TO NEW HAMPSHIRE RESIDENTS. NHIIS IS AUTHORIZED IN ACCORDANCE WITH RSA 141-C:20-F AND MANAGED BY THE NEW HAMPSHIRE IMMUNIZATION PROGRAM (NHIP).

THE DATA FOR THE NHIIS IS COLLECTED BY PERMISSION OF PATIENTS AND/OR THEIR PARENTS/GUARDIANS AT THE TIME OF ADMINISTRATION OF IMMUNIZATION(S). IF PERMISSION IS GRANTED, THE IMMUNIZATION INFORMATION WILL BE INPUT INTO THE NHIIS.

NEW BOSTON CENTRAL HAS BEEN AUTHORIZED BY THE SCHOOL BOARD TO PARTICIPATE IN THE NHIIS REGISTRY. THIS PARTICIPATION IS A READ-ONLY ACCESS BY THE SCHOOL TO CHECK FOR PROOF OF IMMUNIZATION. THE SCHOOL WILL NOT BE INPUTTING ANY DATA INTO THE SYSTEM. THE SCHOOL PRINCIPAL, MS. UNDERWOOD, WILL SUBMIT THE APPROPRIATE PAPERWORK TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES TO PARTICIPATE IN THE NHIIS REGISTRY. MS. DUDAS, SCHOOL NURSE, WILL COMPLETE THE REQUIRED NHIIS TRAINING PRIOR TO THE IMPLEMENTATION AND ACCESS TO THE REGISTRY. AGAIN, THIS IS A READ-ONLY ACCESS ON THE PART OF THE SCHOOL. DATA INPUT INTO THE NHIIS SYSTEM IS ONLY GATHERED IF PATIENTS AND/OR PARENTS/GUARDIANS GIVE PERMISSION AT THE TIME OF THE IMMUNIZATION(S). THE SCHOOL'S USE OF THE REGISTRY WOULD ONLY BE TO CHECK FOR PROOF OF IMMUNIZATION.



Kindergarten & 1st Grade Registration for the 24-25 school year opened on January 29th!

- PARENTS ARE ENCOURAGED TO ENROLL KINDERGARTEN, READINESS AND 1ST GRADE STUDENTS FOR THE 2024-2025 SCHOOL YEAR
 USING OUR ONLINE REGISTRATION SYSTEM. WE WILL BE HOLDING INFORMATION SESSIONS AND SCREENINGS IN EARLY SPRING.
 PLEASE REGISTER YOUR CHILD TO ENSURE YOU RECEIVE LETTERS FROM US REGARDING THESE EVENTS. (IF YOUR CHILD ALREADY
 ATTENDS PRESCHOOL OR KINDERGARTEN AT NBCS YOU DO NOT NEED TO REGISTER)
- DEPENDING ON THE YEAR WE CAN TYPICALLY HAVE BETWEEN TWO TO FOUR KINDERGARTEN SESSIONS AND THREE OR FOUR 1ST GRADE CLASSES AND THEREFORE NEED TO PLAN STAFFING NEEDS ACCORDINGLY. BY REGISTERING EARLY THIS HELPS US GET A HEAD COUNT FOR BUDGETING AND STAFFING PURPOSES.
- YOUR CHILD MUST BE FIVE YEARS OLD BY SEPTEMBER 30TH 2024 TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR PUBLIC KINDERGARTEN AND 6 YEARS OLD BY SEPTEMBER 30TH 2024 TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR 1ST GRADE AND READINESS.
- TO HELP YOU PREPARE TO REGISTER YOUR CHILD YOU WILL BE ASKED FOR THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS DURING THE REGISTRATION PROCESS
 - o A COPY OF YOUR CHILD'S BIRTH CERTIFICATE.
 - o A COPY OF YOUR CHILD'S IMMUNIZATION RECORD.
 - o A PHYSICAL EXAMINATION FOR YOUR CHILD BY A QUALIFIED PHYSICIAN WITHIN ONE YEAR PRIOR TO ENTERING SCHOOL.
 - o TWO PROOFS OF RESIDENCY -

(IN THE UNUSUAL CASE THAT THESE ARE NOT AVAILABLE, A SIGNED AND NOTARIZED STATEMENT OF RESIDENCE MUST BE SUBMITTED.)
